2022 Membership Information

We are confident that the 2022 Memberships offered at Harkers Hollow Golf Club will be the best golfing, dining, and membership value you will find in the area. The golf course and overall facility has undergone vast improvements in our first four years of ownership. We will continue to invest in and improve the course conditions, infrastructure, marketing, food and beverage operation, staff training and overall experience for all our guests. The momentum from our initial revitalization efforts will continue in 2022 and beyond.

2022 Platinum Membership Narrative

Our current business model regarding golf is to offer two membership categories (Platinum and Anniversary), be open for daily fee patrons and host a limited amount golf outings/charity events.

In 2021 we had approximately 165 individuals as Platinum members. This number is just about perfect for our model. For the 2022 season, we will limit the number of Platinum Members at 175 people. We will offer “open enrollment” for existing 2021 members on January 2, 2022. We will open the Platinum Membership category to non 2021 members on February 1, 2022. The total number of new Platinum memberships available will be determined on the number of returning members.

The original Anniversary membership offer was a 3-year commitment and expires 7/1/22. We will be offering a similar membership category option in early 2022. The second offering of this membership category will be a 2-year commitment at \$149 per year. The same stipulations (3-day advanced tee time booking, valid weekends and holidays after 11am) will remain in place for this category. A cart fee of \$23 per person per round will also be part of the new Anniversary membership.

Our anticipated 2022 rates for daily fee guests are listed on page 5 of this packet.

Golf outings/charity events are an important part of our golf business. We currently host all Phillipsburg High School sports fundraiser golf events, multiple volunteer Fire Company fundraisers, cancer benefits, and church functions of multiple denominations. In March of 2022 a complete calendar of outside events will be distributed to the Platinum membership.

Harkers Hollow Golf Club Course Rules and Regulations

The Rules of Golf of the United States Golf Association (“U.S.G.A.”) together with the Rules and Etiquette as adopted by the U.S.G.A. shall be the rules of the Club, except when in conflict with local rules or with any of the rules herein. All players are expected to learn and observe the fundamentals of golf etiquette.

- Appropriate golf attire is required for all players on the golf course. Collared golf shirts and no denim or blue jeans are permitted.
- **Players late for their starting time lose their right to the starting time and shall begin play only at the discretion of the Golf Shop personnel/Starter.** All members and guests must register in the Golf Shop before beginning play. Failure to check in and register **fifteen minutes** prior to a reserved starting time may cause cancellation, set back or a no-show fee to be charged.
- Slow play is not tolerated. In the interest of all, players should play without delay. No player should play until the players in front are safely out of range. If a foursome or other group of players is unable to maintain adequate pace of play and fails to keep their place on the course, they must allow the following group to play through. Player assistants have the authority to stop a slow playing group to allow the following group(s) to play through or to require the slow playing group to pick up their balls and move forward to catch up with the group ahead.
- **All twosomes will be paired whenever possible. At no time should anyone expect to play as a single or twosome.**
- Foursomes control speed of play. Twosomes and threesomes should not expect to play through foursomes and should not exert pressure on the groups ahead. Foursomes shall have the right of way.
- Fivesomes are only permitted at the sole discretion of the golf shop.
- All golfers must have a starting time reserved. The staff will assign the starting time depending on availability. Starting times may be made in person or by phone during Golf Shop hours. Internet reservations may be made twenty-four hours a day.
- No beverage coolers are permitted on the golf course unless supplied by the Club.
- **All alcohol MUST be purchased from Harkers Hollow Golf Club.**
- “Cutting-in” is not permitted at any time. All players must register with the golf shop and start on #1 unless otherwise directed by the Starter.
- Player assistants may be on duty to help regulate play and enforce golf cart restrictions. The player assistants have full authority on the golf course to enforce all rules and speed of play.

- All players who stop after playing nine holes for any reason must occupy the next tee before the following players arrive at the tee or they will lose their position on the golf course and must get permission from the starter to resume play.
- “Discontinue Play (Rain) Policy”: Once players tee off, they are responsible for nine holes. If players discontinue play before 5 holes, they will be issued an 18-hole rain check, after nine holes, they will be issued a 9-hole rain check. Once players begin play the 14th hole, no rain check will be issued.
- If lightening is in the area, all golf play shall cease, players should seek appropriate shelter immediately.
- The Golf Course Superintendent is authorized to determine when the golf course is suitable for play and whether carts will be allowed. The decision of the Golf Course Superintendent shall be final. In the absence of the Golf Course Superintendent, the Golf Professional on duty shall make this decision.
- Management may close the golf course to play at any time, at its sole discretion.
- While playing on the course, each player must use a separate set of golf clubs and bag.
- Players who fail to cancel their starting time 24 hours prior to their scheduled starting time may be charged a no-show fee (1/2 of a cart fee per person).

Your 2022 Membership benefits (excluding pool) begin the day you sign this agreement until March 31, 2023. All proration, refunds or credits are on a case by case basis and at the full discretion of the ownership group of Harkers Hollow Golf Club.
